

Day 1

Upon arriving at SSK Airport you will be met by your guides waiting to take you to your hotel. Check in and if the day allows go on a 3hr city tour of Gaborone.

Accommodation: Masa Square Hotel

Meals: Dinner



Gaborone is the capital city of Botswana. It's known for the Gaborone Game Reserve, sheltering native animals like wildebeest and impala, plus resident and migratory birds. To the city's southwest, rhinos and giraffes inhabit the Mokolodi Nature Reserve. Footpaths lead to city views at the summit of Kgale Hill. In the city center, the National Museum and Art Gallery displays art and cultural artifacts.

Day 2

Our day starts with a 40km drive North of Gaborone, to a village of Mochudi home to the Bakgatla Tribe. Here we will do a historical tour of Phuthadikobo Museum. After Mochudi we drive to another village of Oodi, where we are taken on a tour of the Lentswe la Oodi Weavers. After Oodi, it will just be time for a mouthwatering lunch at Botswana Craft and get a chance to taste some local prepared dishes. After our lunch we tour the craft shop and see all the different crafts made in Botswana. Later we visit the Pelagano Pottery in Gabane and do a pottery tour. We then drive to a village of Manyana to view the Bushmen Rock Paintings dating 2000 years ago and also visit the Dr David Livingstones tree and learn why that tree has been protected as a monument of Botswana. After here we heard back to Gaborone.

The **Tuli Block** is a narrow fringe of land at Botswana's eastern border wedged between Zimbabwe in the north and east and South Africa in the south. It consists mainly of privately owned game farms offering safari tourism. Here lies the Mashatu Game Reserve.

Day 3

Day 3 is our day of travel, After breakfast we head North on the A1 road passing through Mahalapye, Palapye and Bobonong all the way to Mashatu Game Reserve. The travel is just about 8 hours (558km) with rest stops on the way and lunch. Upon arrival we will be met and welcomed by the Mashatu Tented Camp Staff, we then check in and rest the day.

Day 4

On this day we will experience the Safari experience around Mashatu Game Reserve. Game drives are conducted on a 4x4 open Safari vehicle by professional guides and trackers. On this day the itinerary will be guided by the tour guide on the specifics of the day.

Day 5

After our Breakfast we depart Mashatu for Nata, 528 km heading North of Botswana. Our drive should take us 7 hours 30 minutes. On our way we will pass through Botswanas second biggest Town called Francistown. We will also allow time for short rests and Lunch on the way. Upon arrival we check in and rest the day.

Day 6

In the morning after breakfast we do a game drive in Nata Bird Sanctuary, as we view the beautiful Birds that are protected in this area. After this we return back to the lodge for lunch. Later in the afternoon we go for a quad bike tour along the river.

Chobe National Park is in northern Botswana near the vast, inland Okavango Delta. It's known for its large herds of elephants and Cape buffalo, which converge along the Chobe Riverfront in the dry months. Lions, antelopes and hippos inhabit the woods and lagoons around Linyanti Marsh. The floodable grasslands of the Savuti Marsh attract numerous bird species, plus migrating zebras.

Day 7

In the morning after breakfast we drive to Kasane, 315 km from Nata. We should be in Kasane just before lunch. We then check in and rest and have our lunch. Later on the day we go for an afternoon boat cruise in Chobe River, our boat cruise should last for 3 hours and after we return back to our lodge.

Day 8

Full day Chobe National Park with professional guides, a bush lunch prepared by professional chef. Here we will not miss anything and if we are lucky we will be able to see a kill.




Day 9




Day 10

In the morning we depart Kasane for Nxamaseri, this route takes us into Namibia and kindly note visas may be required for a road transit. Kindly check if you require visas for Namibia. The transfer is 522 km through the Caprivi Game Park in Namibia and should take us 6 hours with rest stops on the way. Upon arriving we will be met by our guides who will transport us to the Island in the Okavango Delta. We will check in and rest the day.

The Tsodilo Hills are a UNESCO World Heritage Site (WHS), consisting of rock art, rock shelters, depressions, and caves. It gained its WHS listing in 2001 because of its unique religious and spiritual significance to local peoples, as well as its unique record of human settlement over many millennia. UNESCO estimates there are over 4500 rock paintings at the site. The site consists of a few main hills known as the Child Hill, Female Hill, and Male Hill.

Day 11

Visiting this area of Botswana cannot be visited without visiting the Tsodilo Hills, here we will also view the Bushmen Rock Paintings. We will visit the tsodilo in the morning and later on the day return back to the lodge

Khama Rhino Sanctuary is a community based wildlife project in Botswana. The animal shelter was established in 1992 to assist in saving the vanishing rhinoceros, restore the historic wildlife populations and provide economic benefits to the local Botswana community through tourism and the sustainable use of natural resources. Covering approximately 8585 hectares of Kalahari Sandveld, the sanctuary provides prime habitat for white and black rhinos as well as over 30 other animal species and more than 230 species of birds



Day 15

In the morning after breakfast we break camp and drive out of CKGR, and our next stop is Khama Rhino Sanctuary. Our drive should take just about 6 hours with short stops on the way.
